FAQ's

- **Arrival & Departure?** Please arrive by 7:00pm CT on Friday and depart by 11:00am CT on Sunday.
- **Is this for middle school students only?** YES, youth in grades 6-8 only
- **Chaperones?** Yes, you need them: We recommend 1 adult per 7 youth. You will need male & female chaperones if you have both genders attending.
- **What if we can't find enough chaperones?** Please contact us so we can assist you in arranging adequate supervision.
- **Who is leading?** High school youth from a variety of churches in the Presbytery of Florida.
- **What can we expect from this weekend?** A time to retreat, relax, recharge and reconnect. There will be keynotes, worship, small groups, recreation, and lots of fellowship, all in the beauty of God's creation at Dogwood Acres!
- **Where will we stay?** In the cabins at Dogwood. Your group will be housed together, based on gender.
- **How do I sign up, if I am not coming with a church?** Just fill out this form, enter your family information, and contact DWA. There are a limited number of spots for individual registrations.
- **How do I sign up?** Group leaders should fill out the group registration, and participants within a group should fill out the *Participant Agreement* available on the Dogwood website.
- **What if I need to add more youth?** Contact DWA ASAP and, if there is space available, you can bring your extra youth.
- **What if youth cancel?** That's okay. Just let DWA know ASAP, so someone else can have their slot.
